

## ISTEP

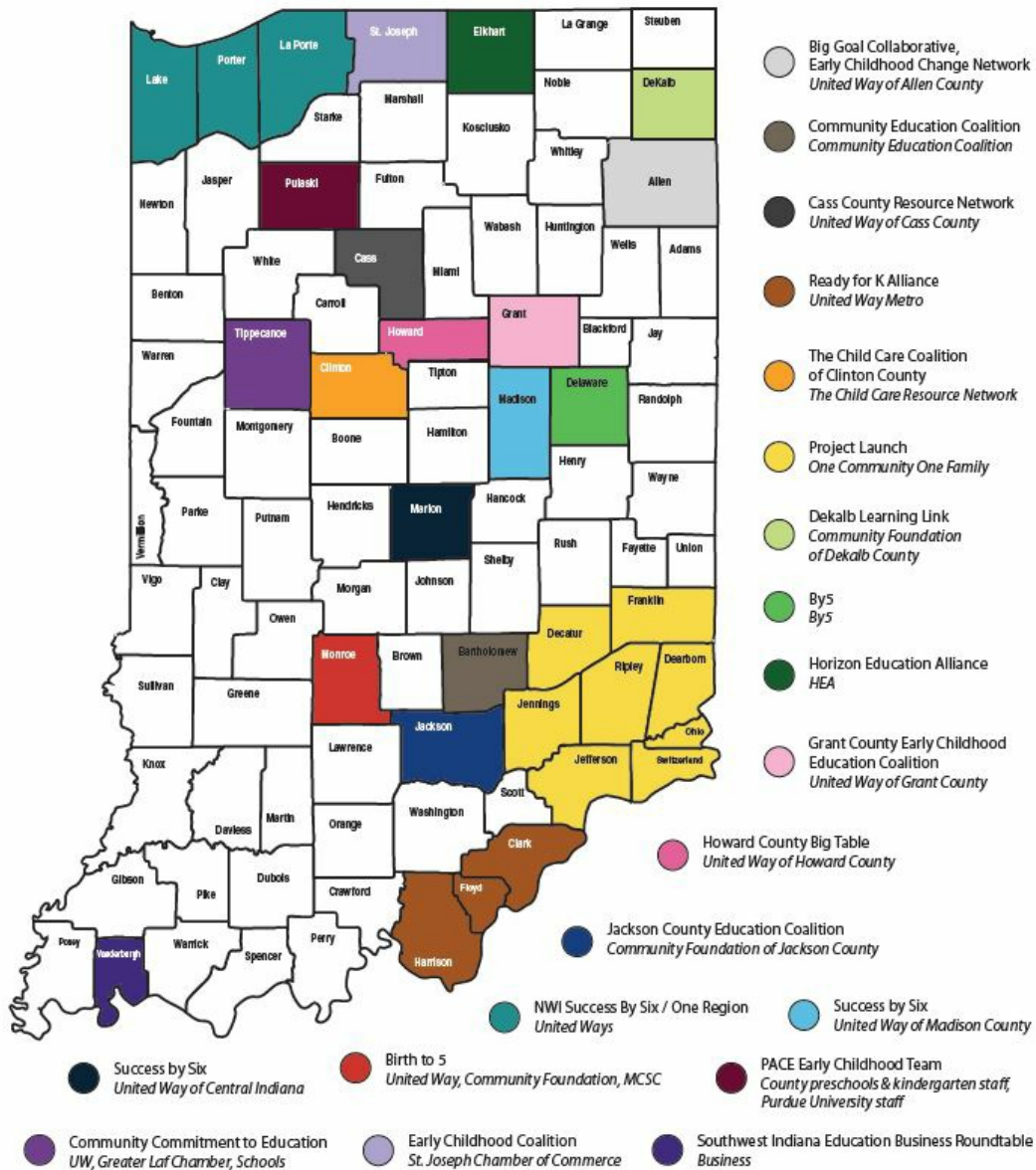
The preliminary ISTEP+ results are now available in PANext for corporations and schools. The Parent Portal opened Monday, June 19 with Spring 2017 student score information. The Spring 2017 ISTEP+ Rescore window opened June 19, 2017 and will be available through July 7, 2017. 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## **Seclusion and Restraint**

In 2013 SEA 345 was passed requiring schools to have seclusion & restraint plans in place. Two key aspects of those plans involve staff training and monitoring the incidences of seclusion and restraint. A part of the law also requires that schools review and revise their plans annually. Please don't let this fall off of your radar. SEA 61 made a few changes to the law during the 2017 session. There are a variety of groups that continue to watch the implementation of this law closely. If you have questions about SEA 345 or SEA 61 requirements, feel free to contact INPEA.
