



## **Provisional Membership Status Indiana Non-Public Education Association**

### **Overview:**

The Indiana Non-Public Education Association (INPEA) is pleased to introduce a **Provisional Membership Status** to provide eligible start up non-public schools that have not yet enrolled students with an opportunity to experience the benefits of INPEA membership at a reduced commitment level. This status is designed to enhance engagement with the INPEA community while offering valuable resources and networking opportunities for schools beginning operations. The provisional status is intended as a pathway to full INPEA membership.

### **Provisional Membership Details:**

- **Membership Fee:** \$250
- **Duration:** One (1) year, renewable for a maximum of one (1) additional year
- **Eligibility:** Open to non-public schools that are in a start-up mode but have not begun operations and are considering full INPEA membership

### **Benefits of Provisional Membership:**

1. **Access to INPEA Communications:** Members will receive newsletters, policy updates, advocacy alerts, and other relevant communications to stay informed on critical issues affecting non-public education in Indiana.
2. **Website Resources:** Provisional members will have access to INPEA's online resource library, which includes best practices, policy updates, legislative insights, and operational guidance.
3. **Discounted Conference Registration:** Members will be eligible for reduced rates on INPEA's annual conference and other professional development events, providing valuable networking and learning opportunities.

### **Renewal and Transition to Full Membership:**

- Provisional membership is available for a maximum of two years (initial year plus one renewal, if needed).
- After the second year, the organization must transition to full INPEA membership to continue receiving benefits.

By offering this provisional membership, INPEA aims to support schools beginning operations in Indiana by providing broader networking, education, and guidance about operating a non-public school in Indiana.
